

Tanzania Compact Progress

- ★ **Energy Sector Project:** MCA-Tanzania launched the procurement for the construction of the 40km, 100MW Zanzibar Interconnector Cable, and expects to evaluate proposals this quarter. This project will improve electricity service and coverage through the addition of new power generation, transmission and distribution capacity. Environmental and social preparatory work associated with the upgrade of transmission systems and distribution line extensions in six underserved regions of Tanzania continues.
- ★ **Transport Sector Project:** In December 2009, MCA-Tanzania awarded a construction contract for the 65km road in northeastern Tanzania connecting the seaport of Tanga with Horohoro near the Kenyan border. This is the first of several construction

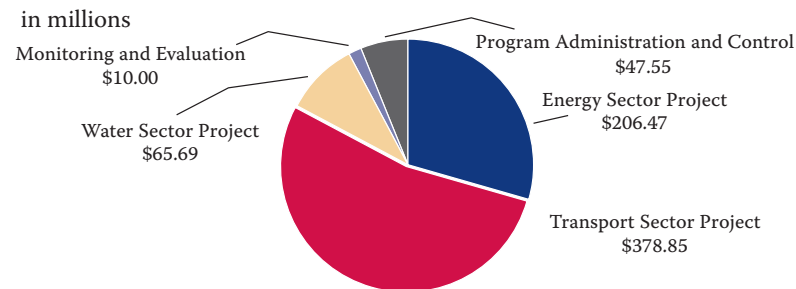
contracts expected to be awarded over the next few months. The rehabilitation of the Tanga – Horohoro road will pave the last unpaved segment between Dar es Salaam and the Kenyan market, reducing the transportation costs between these two markets.

- ★ Feasibility, updated design, and environmental and social preparatory work began for the Zanzibar Rural Roads Activity on Pemba Island in October 2009.
- ★ **Water Sector Project:** MCA-Tanzania recently launched the procurement to conduct a baseline study and prepare technical specifications for the Non-Revenue Water Activity in the city of Dar es Salaam. This activity will reduce water waste and will improve the long-term financial viability of the local water utility.

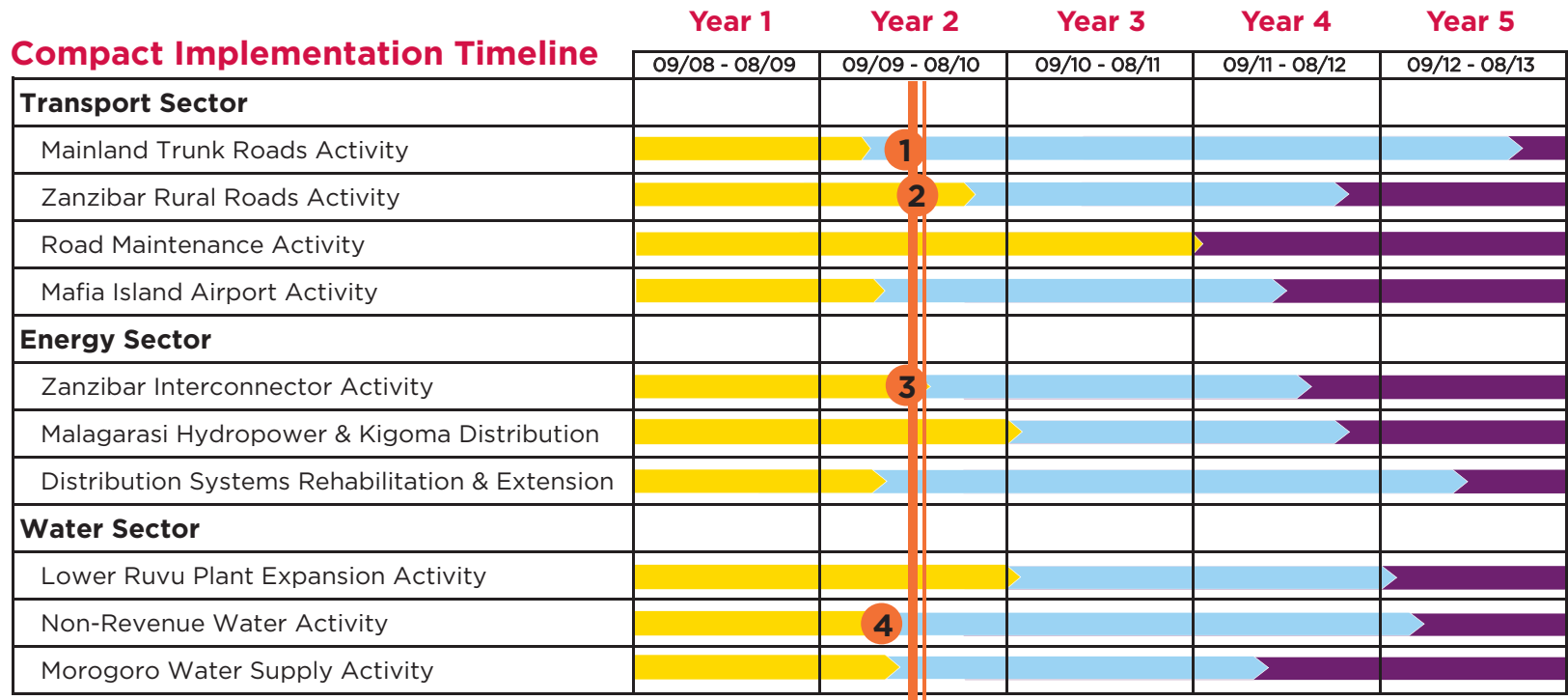
